



# Request for Shared Glass Recycling bins in Multi-unit Developments

Owners Corporations, owners and residents living in multi-unit developments can request a review of the glass recycling bin arrangement.

The three overall options for consideration which are:

- 1) **Standard** glass recycling bins – Each unit has their own set of four individual waste bins (including general rubbish, mixed recycling, glass recycling, and garden organics)
- 2) **Shared** glass recycling bins – For the whole development, each unit has their own set of three individual waste bins (general rubbish, mixed recycling, garden organics), and each unit shares one set of 'communal' glass recycling bins.
- 3) **Combination** glass recycling bins – This arrangement is a combination of standard and shared glass recycling bins. Some units have their own set of four individual waste bins, and some units have their own set of three individual waste bins (general rubbish, mixed recycling, garden organics) and use a set of shared 'communal' glass recycling bins.

A request to transition a glass recycling bin from an individual bin to a shared bin, or a shared bin to individual bin, must be approved by Council, owners and/or their representative.

## Number of shared glass recycling bins

One 120L glass recycling bin will be provided for every two units.

## Storage

Shared glass recycling bins are to be stored in a common area of the development that is accessible to all residents using the shared glass recycling bin arrangement.

## Cost of Service

Households will have the same waste charge for a shared or individual glass recycling bin.



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## Process

Before getting shared glass recycling bins, start with speaking with your neighbours and your Owners Corporation. If the whole development, or some units within the development would like to apply for a shared glass recycling bin arrangement, a formal written application is required.
